tenth edition of Manifesta, the European
Biennial of Contemporary Art.

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Hosted by the State Hermitage Museum, which celebrates its 250th year in 2014, Manifesta 10 will be largely located within the historic Winter Palace and the General Staff Building — the newly renovated modern and contemporary galleries of the Hermitage. Various projects and special Manifesta 10 public programs will also be presented throughout the city, reaching the broader public through events and encounters with contemporary culture outside of the main Manifesta 10 venues, and staging a dialogue between the informal and the official.

Manifesta was founded in 1993 inspired by the changing European constellation brought about by the fall of the Berlin Wall. On its 20th anniversary, curator Kasper König believes Manifesta 10 in St. Petersburg should serve to intensify the artistic exchange made possible by the events of 1989-91.

Around 50 leading contemporary artists from Russia and around the world will participate. A number of artists will create new works specifically for Manifesta 10. The Biennial will be a landmark opportunity to experience and learn more about the geopolitical history of the site and venues, along with various positions within contemporary art, in the company of the works of historical excellence held in the Hermitage's collection. Education and mediation will also play an important role in this Biennial, as it will investigate the notion and the role of contemporary culture in a changing, contested society.
