Emeka Udemba (Germany): "In God We Trust"

After the highly-acclaimed art project *Lagos Open* in Ajegunle, the multi-media artist Emeka Udemba returned to Nigeria in order to realize together with outstanding Nigerian artists another pioneering project in public space in Lagos: *In God We Trust* as an art project will analyze contemporary culture in a social context where faith plays a vital role in the life of the community. It will explore and develop strategies on how creative experiences can be sustained amidst the pressures of religion in a contemporary society and also question issues on relationships between faith, economic and social status of the individual and the community. The project will develop art interventions in collaboration with churches within the Mushin area in Lagos. These interventions in form of installations, paintings, murals, photography, performances and discussions will run simultaneously. The project's core objective is to have art permeate city life, its infrastructure, and its residents. Some of the most prominent Nigerian artists will collaborate with Udemba in this project.
