Born in 1962, in Porto-Novo, in the Republic of Benin, Romuald Hazoumé is one of Africa's most important contemporary artists.

His work has been widely exhibited in major museums and galleries including the British Museum, the Guggenheim, Bilbao, the Centre Georges Pompidou, Paris, ICP, New York and the Mori Museum, Tokyo.

He has also won many prestigious prizes including the Arnold Bode Prize awarded at the Documenta 12 (2007).
